

## **Function**

Symmetrical piston/rod seals are designed to seal the pressurized hydraulic fluid against the atmosphere or between two pressurized spaces.

### **Features**

- ⇒ Symmetrical, single acting piston/rod seal, no interference on the ID or OD.
- $\Rightarrow$  Sharp lips on ID and OD.
- ⇒ Good static and dynamic sealing performance.
- ⇒ Good performance in low pressure conditions.
- $\Rightarrow$  Useable for long stroke lengths.
- ⇒ Out-of date profile; only used in old machineries.
- $\Rightarrow$  Poor sealing that causes a relative thick oil film.

### **Application**

Reciprocating pistons/rods in hydraulic cylinders, plungers etc. Max. pressure 400 bar, max. speed 0.5 m/s.

Snap-in installation.
