



Function

Piston seals are designed to seal the pressurized hydraulic fluid against the atmosphere or between two pressurized spaces.

Features

- ⇒ Asymmetrical, single acting piston seal, designed with interference on the ID which provides a good static fit in the groove.
- ⇒ Dynamic sealing lip shorter than static lip to avoid drag pressure.
- ⇒ Increased preload due to an additional O-Ring
- ⇒ Excellent static and dynamic sealing performance.
- ⇒ Excellent performance in all pressure ranges.
- ⇒ Used for short, pulsating strokes.
- ⇒ No reverse leakage when changing direction.
- ⇒ Recommended for positioning or holding under pressure.

Application

Reciprocating pistons in hydraulic cylinders, plungers, push rods, fittings, etc. Switching or clamping functions

Max. pressure 400 bar, max. speed 0.5 m/s.

Snap-in installation.
